CHAPLAIN COUNSELING AND OTHER
RELATED SERVICES TO CORRECTIONAL INMATES

This is an Agreement between Gary Borders, as Sheriff of Lake County, Florida, a constitutional officer of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as "SHERIFF";

and

the Good News Jail & Prison Ministry, a non-profit corporation, with its principal place of business at 2230 E. Parham Road, Henrico, Virginia, hereinafter referred to as "GOOD NEWS JAIL & PRISON MINISTRY".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, as part of his duties and responsibilities, the SHERIFF operates and controls the Lake County Correctional Facility located in Lake County, Florida, hereinafter referred to as the "FACILITY", and

WHEREAS, in operating the FACILITY the SHERIFF maintains an Inmate Welfare Fund from which inmates incarcerated in the FACILITY purchase and are charged for various items and services; and

WHEREAS, GOOD NEWS JAIL & PRISON MINISTRY'S prime objective and mission is to provide for inmate counseling and other related services for the benefit and well being of the inmates so housed; and

WHEREAS, GOOD NEW JAIL & PRISON MINISTRY has assured the SHERIFF that said Ministry shall provide the inmates necessary counseling and services as more fully described below; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Florida Statute and the Florida Administrative Code, the Welfare Fund Committee has recommended that sufficient expenditures be withdrawn from the Inmate Welfare Fund so that the GOOD NEWS JAIL & PRISON MINISTRY may provide the counseling and services as more fully described below.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises and mutual covenants hereinafter contained, the parties do agree as follows:

1. Recitals. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein.
2. Performance of duties and responsibilities by GOOD NEWS JAIL & PRISON MINISTRY.

GOOD NEWS JAIL & PRISON MINISTRY shall designate and provide to the inmates at the FACILITY a qualified Chaplain who shall perform various counseling and educational services to said inmates. The direct, personal involvement of said Chaplain will be a minimum of 325 hours per quarter. Should the minimum not be achieved, the quarterly payment would be adjusted at the rate of \$23.08 per hour. At the end of each quarter, Good News Jail & Prison Ministry will submit a report detailing the hours spent in the facility by week for each month of the quarter. Such services to be performed shall include, but not be limited to, the following:

- a. Individual and group counseling.
- b. Small group counseling sessions.
- c. Church/religious services.
- d. Special personal growth seminars.
- e. Special holiday activities.

3. Requirements of Accounting. The Chaplain assigned by GOOD NEWS JAIL & PRISON MINISTRY to this Agreement shall provide a monthly accounting for time and activities to SHERIFF through the detention center administration or his designee.

4. Payment for Services. The SHERIFF shall pay GOOD NEWS JAIL & PRISON MINISTRY the sum of thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) for the services rendered pursuant to this Agreement with such sum to be paid in quarterly installments of seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$7,500) beginning at the end of the first quarter of this Agreement. Said sum shall be inclusive of all costs and expenses incurred by GOOD NEWS JAIL & PRISON MINISTRY.

5. Duration of Agreement. This Agreement shall apply from October 1, 2010 and shall be effective continuously through September 30, 2011. Either party may elect to renew this Agreement for additional one year periods upon their mutual written agreement.

6. Termination of Agreement. In the event that either party unilaterally terminates this Agreement, any moneys owed by the Sheriff to Good News Jail & Prison Ministry


shall be paid pro rata for duties and services performed by Good News Jail & Prison Ministry prior to termination in that no further moneys shall be owed or due from the Sheriff for duties or services not performed by Good News Jail & Prison Ministry after the termination. In the event that either party unilaterally terminates this Agreement and any moneys already paid by the Sheriff to Good News Jail & Prison Ministry for duties and responsibilities not performed by Good News Jail & Prison Ministry shall be immediately reimbursed to the Sheriff by Good News Jail & Prison Ministry.

7. Amendments or Modification. This Agreement may be modified by mutual agreement, in writing, between the parties. Further, the parties agree and reserve the right to renegotiate the provisions of this Agreement if operation hereunder is impractical or if there is a revision of any applicable laws or regulations making changes necessary.


8. Absence of Regularly Assigned Chaplain. It is understood that the assigned Chaplain will be permitted a reasonable amount of absences from his assigned duties in accordance with the minimum hourly requirements as stated in item 2, because of attendance at the GOOD NEWS JAIL & PRISON MINISTRY Annual Conference or because of prescribed annual or sick leave or emergencies beyond his control. During all periods of absence, GOOD NEWS JAIL & PRISON MINISTRY agrees to, and shall ensure that, appropriate and sufficient replacement services are provided.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto, via the signatures of the persons named below who are their authorized representatives, agree to be bound by this Agreement as set forth above.
